- Diphtheria/Tetanus
- Hepatitis A
- Polio
- Tetanus
- Typhoid

Like any other professional, your Doctor is entitled to charge a fee for work that does not fall under the umbrella of the NHS. This includes provision of the following travel health vaccines and paperwork:

- **Payment is due prior to vaccinations being given: card, cash or cheque**
- **It is your responsibility to ensure that you have the recommended vaccines**
- **Please take into account that only two vaccinations are recommended at any one time**
